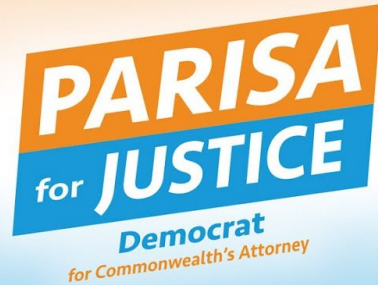


VOTE FOR REFORM ON **JUNE 11!**



Friends,

As I previously wrote, I'm writing a series of emails to give you the indisputable facts about our criminal justice system. The first email was on [sexual assault](#). Now I'm setting the record straight about restoration of voting rights.

2. Voting Rights

Just three years ago, **my opponent signed onto a brief opposing restoration of voting rights for over 200,000 Virginians** who had served their sentences. She willingly joined a Republican [effort to suppress voting rights](#) set to go before Virginia Supreme Court justices who were all [appointed by the Republican legislature](#). She now says she supports voting rights, but didn't want felons to get their gun rights back. That doesn't fully represent what she said at the time. [Her brief emphasized her desire to keep returning citizens off juries and insisted that, even after they had served their time, some individuals were not "deserving" of voting rights.](#)

It's also important to know that **restoration of gun rights requires petitioning the court and proving good cause to have rights restored**. I support making it even more difficult to have gun rights restored.

As your Commonwealth's Attorney, **I will wholeheartedly support the restoration of voting rights.**
